The Transition Bursary Program is for self-advocates who are 18 years of age and older during the 2020 calendar year who have applied, or will be applying, for Passport - Community Participation Supports funding

Once the applicant has been approved and receiving funds for Passports –Community Participation Supports funding the applicant’s individual WRDSS Transition bursary will cease and it is the family’s responsibility to advise WRDSS of this change.

It is the applicant’s responsibility to know the allowable funding guidelines for Passports - Community Participation Supports Funding to ensure proper allocation of the bursary funds.

The bursary will be administered from Jan. 1/20 to Dec. 31/20

Bursaries will be distributed based on the number of applicants and WRDSS budget allocations for this program.
